

DANCE REQUIREMENTS

Dancers are required to bring a "dance bag" with the following items:

- water bottle
- dance shoes appropriate to the class they are taking
- snacks if they are at the studio for an extended period
- extra hair ties/bobby pins and a hair brush
- any medication and personal items the dancer may require

Dancers are to wear dance wear or active wear to every class. No general street clothes or school uniforms including graphic tees are allowed. Each dancer must own a minimum of one Pulse branded top to be worn with black shorts or tights on compulsory uniform days and performances.

Ballet students must wear a leotard and pink ballet tights or socks to every class

Dancers are to arrive and leave classes in casual shoes and change into dance shoes before the commencement of classes. Dance shoes must never be worn outside the studio as it will cause undue damage to the shoes and can also damage our Tarkett flooring.

Please note the "dance bag" does not have to be of a dance brand. Any bag is fine but we suggest your dancers have a specific bag for dance purposes so they do not forget their belongings.

MUSIC REQUIREMENTS

Music students are required to bring the following items:

- an A4 display book with all relevant sheet music (no lose sheet music)
- grade books they are currently working on
- instrument if applicable (guitar or bass)
- Accessories relevant to instrument (drum sticks, picks, capo, tuner)

Music students must have access to a practice instrument at home after the first term of lessons. Discuss with Kat suitable and affordable options for your child

Band class students will have a compulsory band tee.

All uniforms, shoes, tights, strings, picks, music books and other accessories can be purchased directly from us. Please see the website to purchase online for pick up in lessons.

We provide this service to you only on the condition that you accept all of the Terms and Conditions stated in this Agreement.

This Agreement will take affect the moment your booking is made via the website, MusicBiz Customer portal, membership is paid or lessons commence, whichever is earliest

If you do not agree with this Agreement, you are not granted permission to access or otherwise use our Service.

All references herein to "We" or "Us" or "Our School" or "Pulse" mean Pulse Performing Arts., which operates the Service. All references herein to "Client" or "Student" or "You" or "Account Holder" refer to any user of this Service. Parents/Legal Guardians accept the Terms and Conditions on behalf of their Children. All references to "School Term" or "Term" refer to the Queensland Primary School term calendar. Specific Term dates are outlined in the current parent handbook.

1. All lessons and classes are conducted by dancers, musicians or other performing artists who have undergone tutor training. All staff have a valid QLD Positive Notice Blue Card or Teacher Registration.

Unless otherwise specified by management, scheduling follows the Queensland Primary School Term Calendar. Lessons will not run on public holidays, these lessons will be removed from term invoices. Lessons do run on School Student Free days as we not affiliated with Queensland Education Department.
All new bookings are made only through the MusicBiz portal.

4. An enrolment fee of \$30 must be paid at time of booking before enrolment can be processed. \$10 per extra child in the immediate family enrolled will be added onto the first invoice.

4. Students enrol for the entirety of the School Term and fees are non refundable.

5. Tuition fees are invoiced for the entire term and are due 14 days after the date of invoice to be paid in full or by using our direct debit providers Payrix. We do not accept any increment payments outside of the direct debit system and setting up Direct Debit is the responsibility of the account holder by following the prompts in term invoices.

6. If fees become 14 days overdue a late fee of 10% will be charged. If fees then become 21 days overdue classes will be discontinued until full payment, including late fees has been made. No make-up classes or credits will be applied for discontinued classes. If the account remains outstanding at 28 days overdue it may be referred to debt collection - the client will incur all costs accrued, including surcharges and late fees.

7. Discounts can be applied to term fees following the discounting rubric, details of which can be found on the website and parent handbook.

8. Payments can be made via bank transfer, Credit Card (Ezipayment) or Direct Debit (Payrix). All invoices can be viewed and payments can be made through the ThinkSmart Parent Portal App. Debiting Frequency can be chosen by the customer (fortnightly or monthly). Fees and surcharges are set by Payrix and can be found in the set up process.

9. Enrolment is assumed to continue from term to term and you will continue to be invoiced until notice of un enrolment has been made. Students may only un-enrol at the end of a term - if a student attends lessons in a term then pulls out they will be liable to pay the entire invoice unless there are extenuating circumstances that have been communicated to management. If a student goes 4 or more weeks into a new term without attending class with no notice or response to communication that students enrolment will be cancelled and invoice voided. If they wish to return to lessons they must commence their enrolment process from the beginning again including paying Enrolment fee. If a student in a private lesson choses to withdraw after the commencement of term they are liable to pay the entire term or until their spot is filled, whichever comes first.

10. If a student is absent from class, parents are able to inform the school through the ThinkSmart Portal App or to Management on 0455 849 530 or admin@pulseperformingarts.com.au. Do not message teachers directly. Student absences will not be credited to invoices.

11. In the event of a teachers absence from class, a substitute teacher will be arranged. If no teachers are available at the time you will be informed of the cancellation and a make-up class scheduled. If there is no availability for a make-up class you will be credited the amount to your next invoice. Strictly no refunds.

12. Any staff member of Pulse reserves the right to remove students from a class based on their behaviour. Management does not tolerate any form of harassment from students, parents or any persons dealing with Pulse. In the event of threatening behaviour towards any staff or client, enrolment may be terminated with no refund given and attempts to re-enrol will be reviewed on a case by case basis.

13. It is a requirement of Pulse that all students enrolled in classes are in the appropriate attire for their class genre as specified by management. Dance shoes appropriate to the class genre are a requirement in all classes and no jiffies or socks are allowed at anytime.
